Justification for Real World Testing Approach

At this time, iTreatMD V2 is a Certified electronic health record (EHR) that is primarily targeted at long-term and post-acute care (LTPAC) practices, and our EHI export measures were designed with this setting in mind.

The Real World Testing plan aims to provide easy access to clinicians and their patients to the medical record that documents their most recent visit to or by their treating provider.

Measures Used in Overall Approach

Certification Criteria:

Measure:

Single/Multi patient export – This measure will assess functionality used to export EHI for a single patient as well as a patient population in a production environment.

Justification:

The evaluation of success of extracting and exporting by users of patient reports from multiple practice locations. This will demonstrate the real-world utility of the data export.

Test Methodology:

System logs will be reviewed to determine the existence of exports created or generated for various patients by authorized users.

Expected Outcomes:

Authorized users will be able to successfully export patient encounter notes without developer intervention for any patient encounter.

Summary:

In the normal course of accessing a patient's encounter note, a provider will be able to secure and forward any encounter note to a patient or colleague requesting the complete record. The encounter note may also be sent to the recipient via secure email.

Schedule of key milestones

1Q-2025: Health IT system is fully enabled for use in real world testing.

3Q-2025: Begin making plans to collect data for this RWT measures. If necessary, engage clients to ask for their support and participation in real world testing.

4Q-2025: During the last quarter of the year, the CY 2025 real world test plan will be completed according to ONC and ONC-ACB requirements and expectations. Test results will be prepared for submission.
